Publication ethics and malpractice statement

The journal *Logos* operates according to the principles of transparency, academic honesty and social justice. The stated principles ensure, through publicly available information and electronic support and database, timely information about the processing of personal data, the so-called. "double-blind" review process for evaluating research manuscripts, an editorial board composed of experts, care for the authenticity of research manuscripts and commitment to preventing plagiarism, archiving the process of receiving, evaluating and publishing the content of volumes, and promoting the work of experts of all profiles. Authors, reviewers and editors of *Logos* are required to adhere to the highest standards of publication ethics.

Authors

Manuscripts submitted for publication should be original and scientifically significant. Authors should avoid plagiarism, self-plagiarism, guest authorship, ghost authorship, redundant publications, simultaneous submissions, and any kind of conflict of interest.

Reviewers

Reviewers provide assistance to editors in evaluating manuscripts submitted for publication. Their objectivity, impartiality, respect for differences of opinion, observance of confidentiality, willingness to provide constructive criticism, and avoidance of any kind of conflict of interest, is particularly expected.

Editors

In their decisions about the acceptance or rejection of a manuscript for publication, as well as in their communications with authors and reviewers, editors should be guided by objectivity, impartiality and confidentiality. Editors are also expected to ensure the anonymity of the review process and to avoid any kind of conflict of interest.

The editors ensure that every manuscript received is evaluated according to the scientific quality of the content and the level of quality of the linguistic expression, and not according to the criteria of race, sex, gender, sexual orientation, religious and cultural beliefs, national affiliation, language, citizenship, party affiliation and the like for scientific evaluation content of irrelevant criteria. In order to guide all contributors in their possibilities, rights and obligations, the editors have prepared special instructions for authors and reviewers.
